### Radioactive Iodine Army Holds Called A Disease Cure

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Hertz, on military leave as a research associate at Harvard and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, described the preparation as "artificially induced atomic energy," and said that in its liquid form it was colorless, odorless and tasteless.

He said he was convinced that in many instances it eventually would replace surgery. One drink of it, he said, is usually sufficient to effect a cure.



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
